Tariff Update – Customer FAQ

Effective April 1, 2026

To help clarify recent tariff changes affecting electronic components manufactured in China and Taiwan, MPD has prepared the following Frequently Asked Questions for our customers and distribution partners.

1. Why is MPD implementing a tariff charge?

Recent U.S. import tariffs on products manufactured in **China and Taiwan** have significantly increased the cost of importing electronic components. While these tariffs are imposed externally, they directly affect the cost of bringing products into the United States.

2. What tariff will MPD charge beginning April 2026?

Beginning **April 1, 2026**, MPD will apply a prorated amount of **7% tariff charge** on all products manufactured in **China and Taiwan**, including existing inventory. MPD is **absorbing a portion of these tariffs** to help minimize the impact on our customers and distributors.

3. Are there ways to avoid tariff charges?

Yes. **No tariff charges apply when products are shipped directly from MPD's Hong Kong or Taiwan warehouses.**

For certain projects or large orders, MPD can coordinate **direct international shipment options** that may help customers avoid tariffs depending on their import structure.

4. Does the tariff apply to all MPD products?

The tariff charge applies only to **products manufactured in China or Taiwan and imported into the United States**. Products shipped internationally or from non-U.S. warehouses may not be subject to the same charges.

5. Will MPD continue to try to reduce tariff impact?

Yes. MPD continues to actively evaluate **supply chain options, logistics strategies, and warehouse shipping programs** to minimize tariff impact whenever possible.

6. Can MPD support custom or project-based solutions?

Absolutely. **Custom components and project-based parts are one of MPD's specialties.** Our engineering and manufacturing teams work closely with customers to develop custom solutions that meet specific electrical, mechanical, or environmental requirements.
